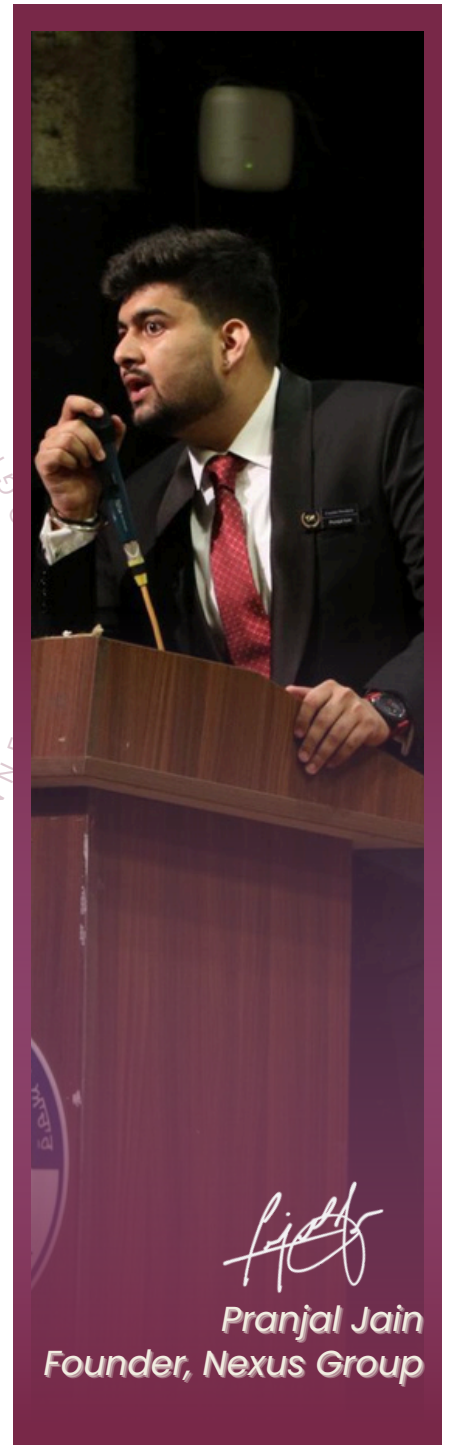

The Best Delegation Trophy is calculated through a transparent, merit-heavy weighted scoring system across all active committees:

Award Category	Points Contributed
Best Delegate (BD)	10 Points
High Commendation (HC)	05 Points
Special Mention (SM)	03 Points



The Calculation of Excellence

The institution with the highest cumulative point score will be crowned the **Nexus Chapter 3 Best Institutional Delegation**. This trophy represents the academic strength and leadership of the entire institution.

The institution awarded **Best Institutional Delegation** will receive a **cash prize of ₹20,000**, granted to the institution as a mark of recognition for overall excellence. This award is separate from the delegate **prize pool exceeding ₹2,00,000**, through which individual delegates will receive their own competitive awards and cash prizes.
